As per 1992 survey, against the identified 1,62,931 BPL families, cards have been issued to 1,83,171 families in the rural areas. So the circulation is more. Steps have been taken to detect the ghost cards circulated.

As per 1997 BPL survey, it was found that 2,21,846 families are below poverty line, So the total BPL families from 1992 census to 1997 census has been further increased by 58915. Again a revision has been made during 1999-2000. In the said revision about 22,000 more BPL families are being detected. So the total BPL families at present would be 2,42,000. Similarly the BPL families in the urban sector are 23,300 as per the 1992 survey. All these figures have created a heavy burden on the district administration. The BPL cards as per 1997 & 1999 survey have not been issued to the families. It is apprehended that the survey report prepared in 1997 has not been made correctly. Steps are being taken to appraise the matter to Govt. of Orissa to find put a solution by way of conducting a fresh survey of the BPL families or by providing cards to the additional BPL families.
